

Standards Applicability Process

Finding the Standards and Elements of Performance That Are Applicable to Your Organization

Not all the standards and elements of performance (EPs) in this manual will apply to every behavioral health care organization because each organization offers different types of programs and services and caters to specific populations. For example, accredited organizations may serve people throughout the life span or specialize in an age or disability group. The settings also vary from facility-based to community-based.

The purpose of this chapter is to help each behavioral health care organization determine exactly which standards and EPs apply to their settings, services, programs, and specific populations. To find out which standards and EPs apply to your organization, please read through the following four steps.

Steps to Determining Your Organization's Applicable Standards and Elements of Performance

Step 1. Reviewing the Common Standards

There are common standards and EPs that apply to every behavioral health care organization regardless of the program, setting, or population. These can be found in Section 1 (pages SAP-3–SAP-6). You will also find that these common standards and EPs are differentiated with a star icon—★—throughout the functional chapters (except the “Leadership” [LD] chapter).

However, certain programs (including **shelters, corrections, and technology-based**) may not have to comply with all the common requirements. This applicability will be noted within Section 1 next to the particular standard or EP.

Step 2. Using the Standards Applicability Table for Programs and Services

The Standards Applicability Table (found in Section 2 on pages SAP-7–SAP-28) identifies which standards apply to the various programs and services available. After reviewing the common standards, you will use this table to identify the additional standards and EPs that apply to your particular organization. Keep in mind that a given standard may apply to the multiple care, treatment, or service settings operated by a single organization.

In the body of the table are several notations to further assist in determining your organization's standards applicability:

Square Bullet (■): Indicates that the EP in the left column applies to the setting or population listed at the top of the table.

24 Hour (24h): Identifies an EP that is applicable only to a given population or service when provided in a 24-hour overnight setting.

When Applicable (WA): Refers to an EP that is scored only when the organization engages in the referenced activity.

When Indicated (WI): Identifies an EP that is applicable based on the needs of any given client receiving care, treatment, or services. The EP is not applicable to the entire population, but may be required for some clients receiving care, treatment, or services.

When Provided (WP): Identifies an EP that is applicable only when the subject is within the scope of the care, treatment, or services offered by the organization.

Business Office (Y): Identifies an EP that applies if a service is provided to the client in a setting that fundamentally functions as a business office. This is used to identify EPs that apply only when

settings that are not designed specifically as service settings provide services within the physical environment of that setting.

Step 3. Determining Additional Standards and Elements of Performance for Specific Populations and Services

In addition to the programs and services provided, there may be additional standards and EPs for your organization's specific populations and services. These additional requirements can be found in Section 3 (on pages SAP-31–SAP-34) and include the following population categories: **addictions, children and youth, opioid treatment programs, persons with developmental disabilities, care coordination, community integration, employment services, family support, and peer support.** These specific populations and services are listed separately to help you identify additional standards and EPs that specifically apply to a population, regardless of the setting in which your clients receive services. (For example, standard PC.3.40 addresses the assessment process for persons with developmental disabilities regardless of the setting in which they are served.)

Step 4. Determining Which Medication Management Standards and Elements of Performance Apply to Your Organization

Organizations surveyed under this manual may not be responsible for all or any of the medication management processes. For example, an organization may permit self administration of medications but not order, transcribe, procure, dispense, store, or have staff administer medications. In such cases, it would have to meet only the standards related to the self administration of medications (MM.5.20) and the monitoring of their effects (MM.6.10).

The standards applicability table shown in Step 2 does **not** provide guidance on the applicability of the Medication Management standards and EPs. Instead, an applicability table is provided at the beginning of the "Medication Management" chapter (pages MM-3–MM-4) to identify the standards and EPs that would apply to your organization's processes for managing medications.

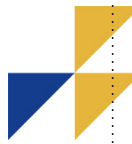

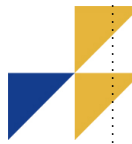
