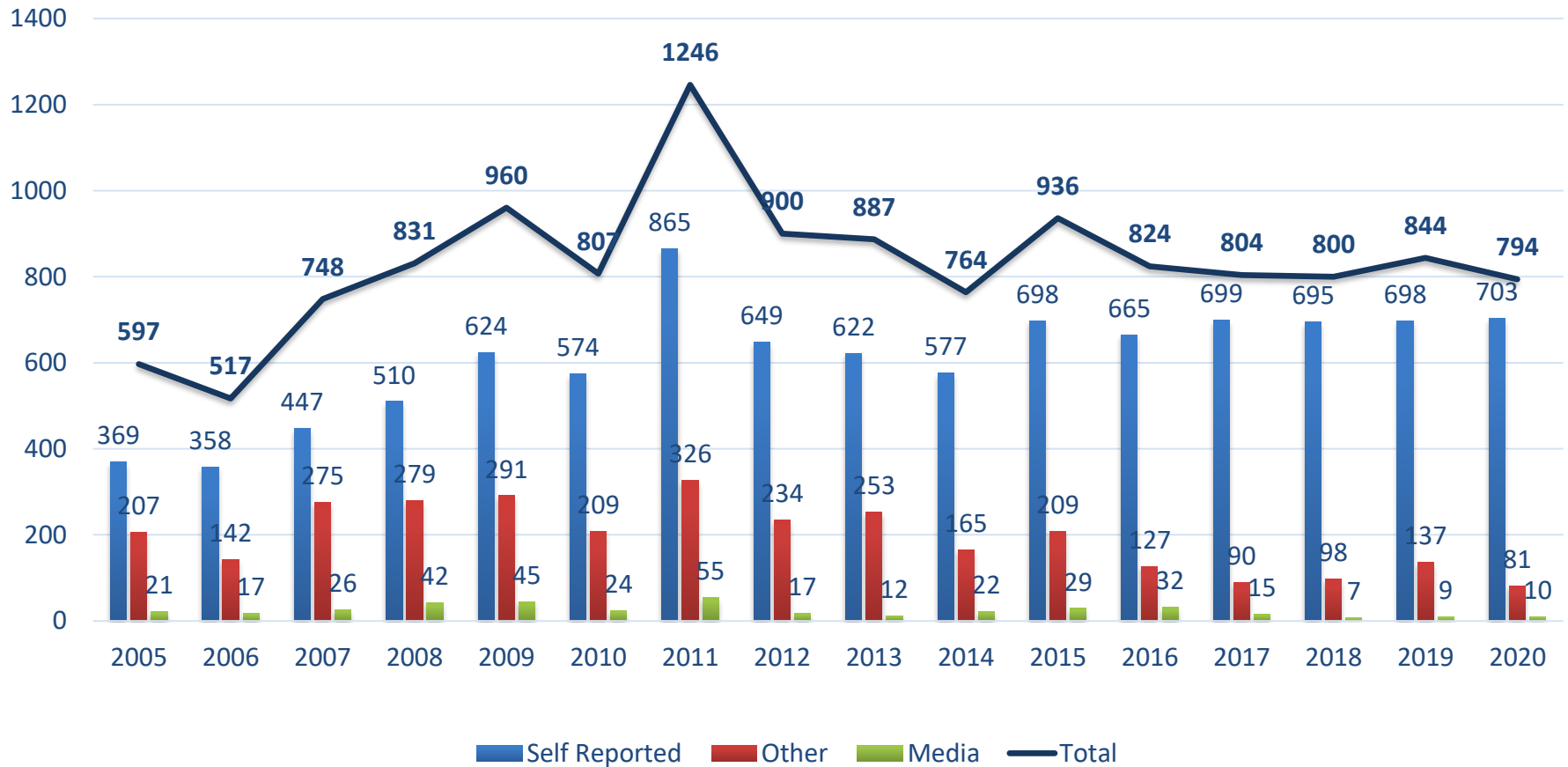

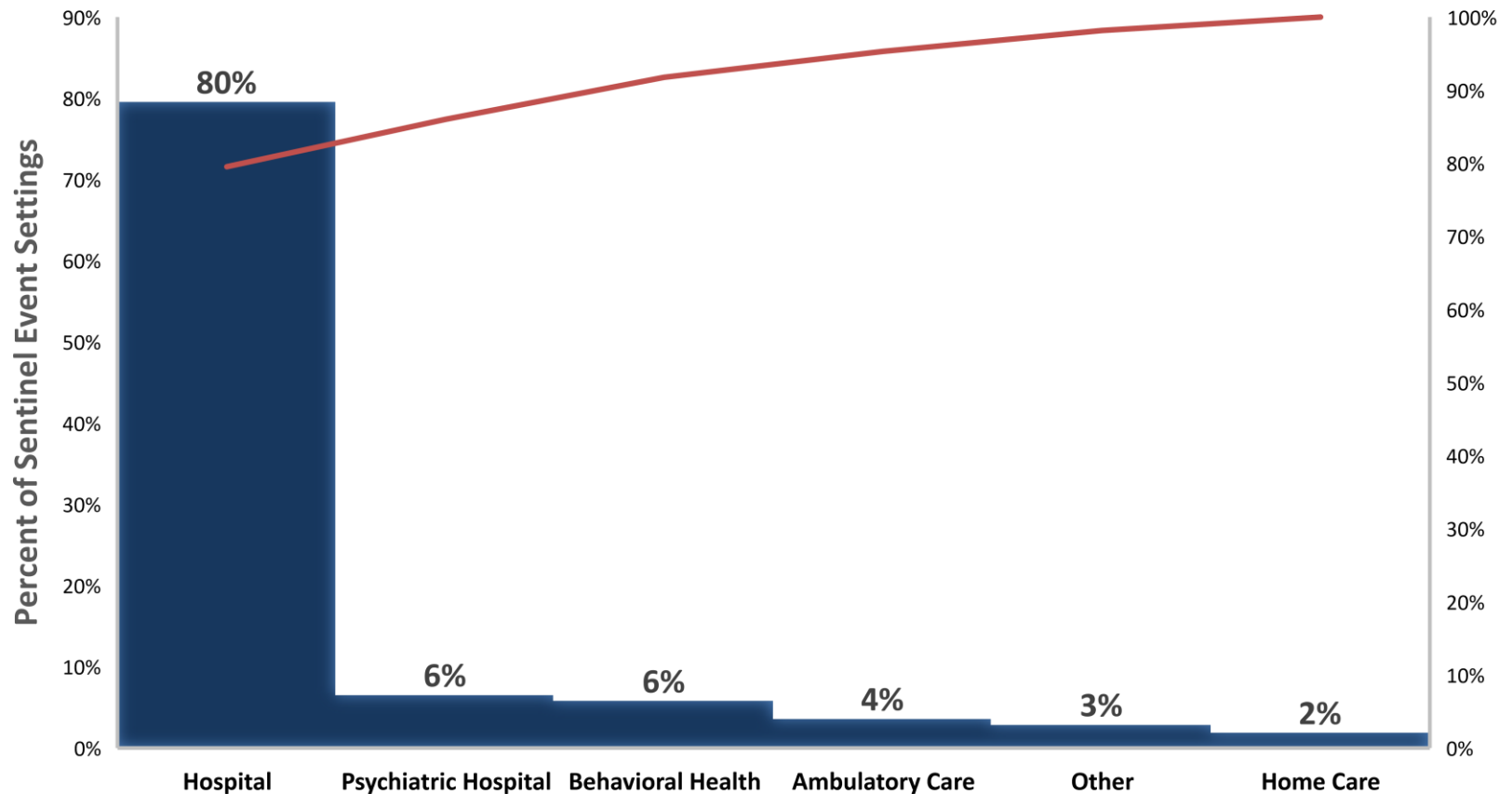

Sentinel Events Reviewed by Year by Source 2005 - 2020



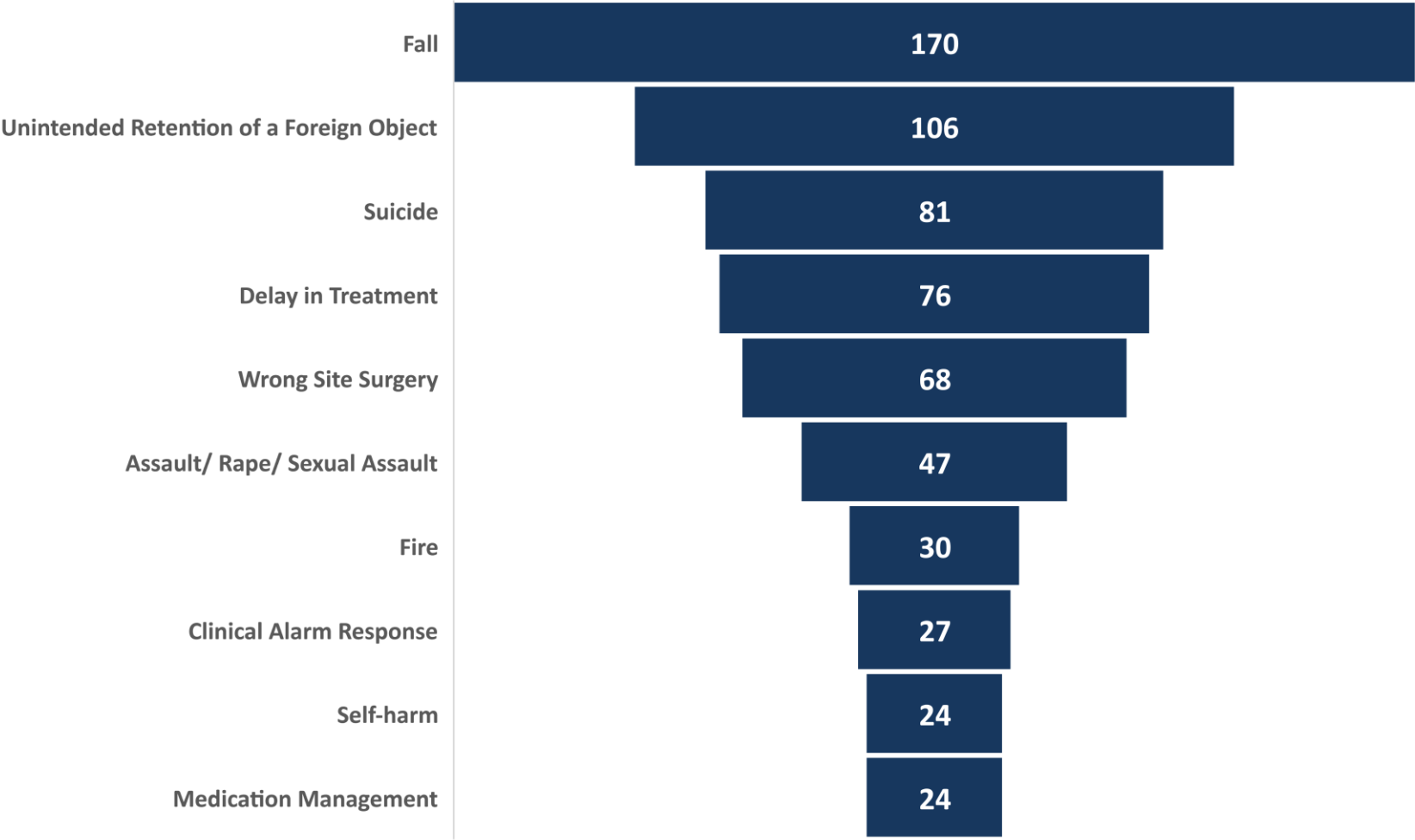
