| 4. | The critical access hospital collects data on the following: <u>Surgeries in which the postoperative diagnosis (clinical or pathological) was unexpected and could indicate that a clinically significant diagnostic error occurred.</u>
<u>Note: The critical access hospital's medical staff determine which unexpected postoperative diagnoses are clinically significant. Examples may include, but are not limited to, the following:</u>
<u>- A preoperative pathology or cytology report was interpreted as a malignancy, but no malignancy was found in the surgical specimen.</u>
<u>- A patient underwent surgery for acute appendicitis, but the appendix was normal on the postsurgical pathology exam.</u>
