THE STUDY: Study conducted in 2021 by independent research firm, The ROI Institute. 161 Joint Commission accredited ambulatory surgery centers provided data. Average number of staff was 15 (range 3-30). Average length of accreditation of ASC respondents was about 9.11 years; range was 1 year – 33 years.
